Guided Tour of Rushton Hall Park, Desborough Road, Rushton, Kettering, NN14 1RR.

Arrive 1.15 for a 1.30pm start.

KHSOGA members £14, non-members £15. This covers a cream tea.

By kind permission of David Pain we have arranged a private tour of the grounds, including the dovecote, wild garden, Dryden's Walk, Battle of Naseby viewpoint, the lake, medieval fishponds, and the hidden chapel and tunnel in Rushton Hall.

David's grandfather, James Pain, purchased Rushton Hall and Estate in 1931. Grade 1 listed in 1951, it was purchased by the Ministry of Works in 1957 and from 1957-2001 it was an RNIB School for blind children.

In 2003 Rushton Hall and 20 acres of land were sold and became Rushton Hall Hotel and Spa.

David continues to farm the Estate and has extensively researched the history of the Hall and its owners.

We will meet outside the Hall on the grassy area at the front where David will give us a brief introduction before leading our tour, which will take approximately two hours before tea and scones are served in the Library.

There will also be the opportunity to view books and information relating to the history of the Hall.

David does not charge for his tours but appreciates donations to the Air Ambulance.

Please arrive promptly wearing shoes suitable for walking across rough ground.

Two car parks are available.

Departure will be at approximately 4.15-4.30pm.

Accessibility: The route is unsuitable for anyone needing a mobility aid. There is an option to walk the first part of the route then return to Rushton Hall. Those unable to join the walking tour may spend the time in Rushton Hall.
